The 2024 Research Innovation and Impact Grant Program is a Program of the Western Australian (WA) Future Health Research and Innovation Fund (FHRI Fund) and the RPH Research Foundation.

The Research Innovation and Impact Grants aim to fund new research projects that challenge existing paradigms. This grant program supports mid-career and senior researchers who are translating their ideas into healthcare innovations that could lead to a significant impact on the health and wellbeing of our community. The research must be undertaken in Western Australia and be of direct relevance to the WA public health system/community.

Applicants can submit projects up to \$1,200,000 for a period of three years.

We encourage applications that demonstrate alignment with the FHRI Fund Focus Areas which include Aboriginal health and/or regional WA health issues, Burden of Disease, COVID-19 and Long COVID and Mental Health.
